

LIGHTFAIR TO OFFER LIGHTING INDUSTRY MENTORSHIP PROGRAM

Mentee applications due March 31, 2021

ATLANTA – March 8, 2021 – LightFair is expanding networking and relationship building opportunities beyond its yearly trade show and conference with a new lighting professional mentorship program launching this spring. The six-month program creates opportunities for experienced and emergent professionals to connect on-to-one, culminating in an in-person networking event at LightFair 2021, October 25-29, 2021 in New York.

"The connections made between lighting professionals is a hallmark of the LightFair experience," said Dan Darby, show director. "Through our mentorship program, we aim to facilitate and support sustainable, effective connections that form the cornerstone of growth, learning and the future of lighting."

Mentors and mentees will be expected to check in at least once per month after they are connected until LightFair 2021. They also will be expected to participate in a private LinkedIn group and report on the program to LightFair.

In addition to a dedicated connection to an experienced lighting professional, mentees will also receive a three-day exhibit hall pass for LightFair 2021, one 60-90 min conference session and complimentary registration to the New Attendee Orientation & Tour at the show.

The program is limited to professionals with 1-3 years of experience in the U.S. and internationally. The application deadline is March 31, 2021. The program kicks off on April 26, 2021.
